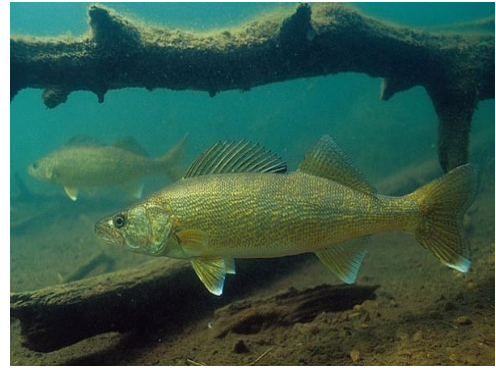


# Water@UW-Madison Spring Symposium
